

# Spring 2026 Costume Information for Set Apart 1A and 2C

Hello parents! This semester has flown by! It is hard to believe it is already time to send out performance information! As you know, we will be holding our dance performance the evening of **Tuesday, May 19th, at 7:00 PM in the Cheyenne Hills Church sanctuary**. Our mandatory dress rehearsal will be held earlier that same day. Exact times and more details will be sent to you when we have them all worked out!

For those of you who are new to Set Apart Girls this semester, I want to let you know first off that we do costuming a little differently than most dance studios. Our costumes are mostly re-usable to keep things easier and more cost effective! So most of the items listed below will be the base items of your dancer's costume each performance, rather than to just use one time. We have class-specific accessories that we will be adding when your dancer arrives for the performance. **Your dancer will need the following items for her COSTUME:**

- A loose fitting, short-sleeved white T-shirt that provides good coverage in all ranges of movement. Make sure it is long enough to cover their stomach when their arms are raised. This should be plain white, with no sparkles or writing. No low V or scoop necks please!
- Light pink footed tights
- Pink ballet shoes
- White satin drop waist skirt (**this you will need to order from me**)



**Skirts are \$25 each. To order your child's skirt, simply text or email me to let me know what your dancer needs, and how you would like to pay (cash, check, or PayPal). I have already measured your girls so I know their sizes :)**

For those of you who already have your girls' skirts from previous semesters, **now is the time to check to make sure it still fits your dancer!** Skirts should hit at least mid-calf, anything higher means your dancer needs a new skirt!

**HAIRSTYLE**– Hair must be done in a nice neat bun, near the middle of the head (not too high, please!), so whatever supplies you need to make a bun, make sure you have those things on hand as well :) We will add hair accessories so that the whole class will match, so when you are putting her hair up, please make sure that the clips/pins/hairties you use blend with her hair color pretty well (no bright hair ties or scrunchies, please:)



**MAKE-UP AND ACCESSORIES**– No jewelry please, unless it's very small and discreet (like stud earrings). For make-up, I just want to let you know that the stage lights are not super bright, so we don't need extremely bold make-up. If you would like to use it, please just use it somewhat moderately, rather than heavy like a typical stage make-up job. Thank you so much!
