

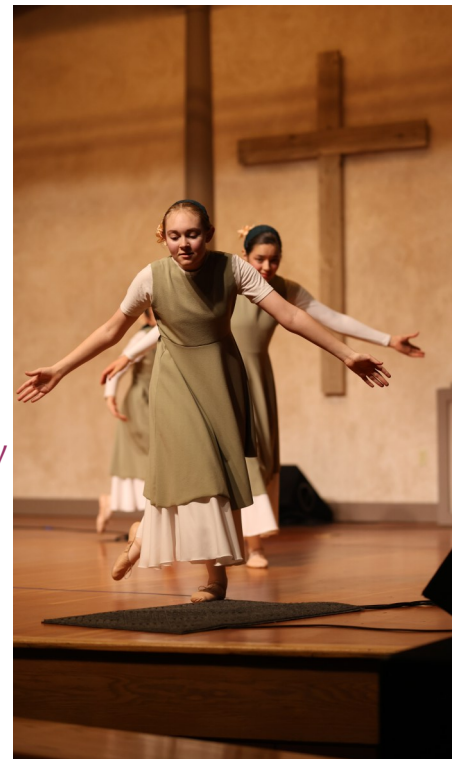
Spring 2026 Costume Information for Set Apart 3A/3B

Hello parents! This semester has flown by! It is hard to believe it is already time to send out performance information! As you know, we will be holding our dance performance the evening of **Tuesday, May 19th at 7:00 PM in the Cheyenne Hills Church sanctuary**. Our mandatory dress rehearsal will be held earlier that same day. Exact times and more details will be sent to you when we have them all worked out!

For those of you who are new to Set Apart Girls this semester, I want to let you know first off that we do costuming a little differently than most dance studios. Our costumes are mostly re-usable to keep things easier and more cost effective! So, the costume items listed below will be the base items of your dancer's costume for this performance, and we will be re-using them with a bit of variation in future performances.

Your dancer will need the following items for her COSTUME:

- Pink ballet shoes
- Light pink (or skin color) footed tights: these can be found online on Amazon, Discount Dance Supply, or at Target!
- White circle skirt and bloomers: this part of the costume you will need to order from me if your dancer does not already have one!
- A short-sleeve white T-shirt that fits well but is not loose. Normally I say loose fitting, but we are going to be wearing tunics like the one pictured here, and I don't want it to look bulky underneath. No low V or scoop necks please! The shirt should be long enough to provide good coverage in all ranges of movement.



To order your dancer's skirt and bloomers, please just let me know via text or email what your dancer needs, and how you would like to pay (PayPal, cash or check)! I have already measured your girls, so I will know their sizes :) **The cost for circle skirt and bloomers together is \$42. Note: If you choose to pay with PayPal, it will be \$44 total.**

For those who already have a circle skirt from previous semesters, please check and make sure it still fits! It needs to reach at least mid-calf length. Let me know as soon as possible if your dancer needs a new skirt and bloomers!

HAIRSTYLE- Please pull your dancer's hair back in a secure, neat bun, quite low, near the nape of the neck. So, whatever supplies you need to make a bun, make sure you have those things on hand as well :) We will add hair accessories so that the whole class will match, so when you are putting her hair up, please make sure that the clips/pins/hairties you use blend with her hair color pretty well (no bright hair ties or scrunchies, please:)

MAKE-UP AND ACCESSORIES- No jewelry please, unless it's very small and discreet (like stud earrings). For make-up, I just want to let you know that the stage lights are not super bright, so we don't need heavy make-up. Please use it somewhat moderately, rather than extremely heavy like a stage make-up job. Thank you so much!
