

Spring 2026 Costume Information for Set Apart 3C

Hello parents! This semester has flown by! It is hard to believe it is already time to send out performance information! As you know, we will be holding our dance performance the evening of **Tuesday, May 19th at 7:00 PM in the Cheyenne Hills Church sanctuary**. Our mandatory dress rehearsal will be held earlier that same day. Exact times and more details will be sent to you when we have them all worked out!

For those of you who are new to Set Apart Girls this semester, I want to let you know first off that we do costuming a little differently than most dance studios. Our costumes are mostly reusable to keep things easier and more cost effective! This semester, you will only need to purchase a few items for your dancer's costume, and I will be making and keeping the main parts to re-use for future performances. The finished costume will look very similar to the class pictured here.

The parts of the **COSTUME** that you will need to buy (and will be keeping) are the following items:

- Pink ballet shoes
- Black ankle length leggings (just like the ones we wear for normal classes). Make sure these are solid black, and no holes, please :)
- A long sleeved black leotard. I order mine online at Discount Dance Supply, and recommend the Theatricals or Capezio Women's Long Sleeve Dance Leotard. I also recommend going with a size larger than your dancer normally wears.

NOTE: Leotards should be considered as underclothes, and should not be worn around the church without something over it (like a shirt and pants/skirt)! We will be putting dresses on over the leotards for their costume.

HAIRSTYLE- Please pull your dancer's hair back in a secure, neat bun, quite low, near the nape of the neck. So, whatever supplies you need to make a bun, make sure you have those things on hand as well :) We will add hair accessories so that the whole class will match, so when you are putting her hair up, please make sure that the clips/pins/hairties you use blend with her hair color pretty well (no bright hair ties or scrunchies, please:)

MAKE-UP AND ACCESSORIES- No jewelry please, unless it's very small and discreet (like stud earrings). For make-up, I just want to let you know that the stage lights are not super bright, so we don't need heavy make-up. Please use it somewhat moderately, rather than extremely heavy like a stage make-up job. Thank you so much!
