

Rehearsal and Performance Info, Spring 2026

REHEARSAL INFORMATION:

Our **Mandatory Dress Rehearsal** for classes 1A, 1B, 2A, 2B, 2C, and 2D will be held in the Cheyenne Hills Church sanctuary, on **Tuesday, May 19th, from 12:00 PM—3:30 PM**. All dancers do not need to stay for the whole rehearsal though, just their own class' allotted practice time. When you arrive, please come in through the main church doors, and you will find the entrance to the sanctuary on your right. Find Miss Elisha and she will direct you where to go. If you have questions, she is the one to ask! You can drop your dancer off, or feel free to stay for rehearsal!



As we did last semester, we will be having a finale dance with all dancers participating in it! This is why the rehearsal practice times overlap, so that we can have all dancers at rehearsal together at one point for our finale practice.

COSTUMES for Rehearsal: For those of you who already have costumes from last year, check and make sure you have everything your dancer needs! Please bring your child to rehearsal in full costume. **For those of you who need a white skirt (or white skirt and belt) for your dancer and do not yet have them**, I will be bringing these to the last class practice. If you miss the last class, I will bring your dancer's costume to the dress rehearsal. Please refer to the PARENT PAGE for your dancer's specific costume information.

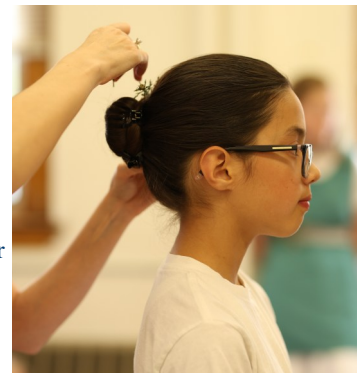

PERFORMANCE

Our performance is Tuesday, May 19th, at 7:00 PM in the Cheyenne Hills Church sanctuary. **All dancers must arrive by 6:15 PM.** They must arrive in full costume and with hair done! Please refer back to the Costume Information documents located directly below these Rehearsal and Performance Info files on the PARENT PAGE for exact costume details for your child's class.

****Note on hair: For dancers whose hairstyle is a bun**, in previous years, I have done some of your girls' buns when they arrived that evening, but we have too many students for me to be able to do that anymore...so please do your dancer's hair before you arrive! You could do a practice bun for a dance class and I will let you know if it's how it needs to be for the real thing. Also, I know that buns can be tricky, so right below these two performance info files on the PARENT PAGE is a link to my favorite easy-bun-making clips! If you decide to use these, just make sure you get ones that somewhat match her hair color :) Reminder: Please do not use any brightly colored hair ties or scrunchies in your dancer's hair.



When you arrive, please bring your dancer to our dressing area, the church café area—when you come in the main church doors, it is the set of wooden doors immediately on your left! We will be adding your dancer's costume accessories there. After the performance, we will take these extra pieces off, but please make sure that your dancer leaves only wearing what she had on when you arrived. Thank you!!
